\$2000 Covid boost for Keppel community groups

More than 50 sporting and community clubs in the Keppel electorate have received \$2000 each as part of the Palaszczuk Government's COVID SAFE Active Clubs Kickstart (Kickstart) program has recently closed.

Kickstart assists not-for-profit local and regional sport and recreation organisations to re-establish their operations post COVID-19 and enable them to provide physical activity opportunities.

The Member for Keppel and Assistant Education Minister Brittany Lauga said Kickstart provides funding for equipment and training to improve the capabilities of local and regional community organisations, as well as purchases for restart post COVID-19 including catering, utilities, ground and facility maintenance costs, safety and sanitisation requirements.

"In Keppel \$108,000 (GST exclusive) in funding has been approved to 54 organisations.

"I believe this COVID-SAFE Restart Plan investment will provide support and recovery efforts as we continue to manager COVID-19," said Ms Lauga.

Among those receiving the \$2000 funding are Yeppoon Australian Football Club Incorporated; Yeppoon Gymnastics & Movement Centre Inc; Capricorn Coast Touch Association Inc.; Yeppoon Indoor Bowling Club Inc.; Emu Park Golf Club Inc.; and Sea Q Board Riders Inc.
