Frenchville school gets \$1 million boost

Rockhampton's largest primary school, Frenchville State School, will receive nearly a million dollars from the Palaszczuk Government to build a hard covered shade structure over courts.

The Member for Keppel and Assistant Education Minister Brittany Lauga said the \$990,000 expenditure for the project is part of a multi-million dollar schools works budget to continue to provide world-class education infrastructure.

"As well as Frenchville SS the government is spending \$990,000 to refurbish the science room at Yeppoon State High School, plus a combined total of \$916,000 for maintenance and minor works at various schools in the electorate."

Ms Lauga said the Palaszczuk Government has recently announced \$220 million to refurbish education facilities in a works program set to create jobs for tradespeople across the State.

She said the allocated funding will both enhance school learning environments while supporting jobs and the local economy during these unprecedented times.

"This is on top of more than \$1 billion already announced for new schools and new classrooms, creating even more jobs across the State in 2020.

"This is all part of Queensland's economic recovery plan to invest in infrastructure across our State and create local jobs."
