## **Shire pathways get \$300K government boost**

Two popular pathways in Livingstone Shire will soon be massively upgraded thanks to \$300,000 from the Palaszczuk Government's Works for Queensland programme.

The Member for Keppel and Assistant Education Minister Brittany Lauga said council had received the funds to upgrade the Taylor Street Pathway and the Swordfish Pathway with work to be completed 31 October, 2020.

"This money is more funding for the council which so far has received \$3.4 million in Works For Queensland allocation.

"The Taylor Street Pathway work will see construction of a concrete shared pathway (approximately 210m) including lighting to provide safe pedestrian and cyclist connections between town activity nodes.

"The Swordfish Pathway will receive construction of concrete shared pathway (approximately 300m) from Cedar Avenue to Remora Park to provide safe pedestrian and cyclist connections between residential nodes, commercial node and the principal cycle network.

"This is a great news for local council jobs and for pathway users."
